Chairman Pettus, upon declaration of a quorum being present, opened the meeting for the transaction of business.

The invocation and Pledge of Allegiance were delivered by Commissioner Garner.

Public Comments on Agenda items: None

Commissioner Parker moved, seconded by Commissioner Garner that all items listed on the regular business agenda be approved for immediate consideration. There being no discussion and upon a vote taken, motion unanimously approved. Agenda is herein recorded and made part of these minutes.

Commissioner Holmes moved, seconded by Commissioner Hackworth that the minutes of the last regular meeting, April 13th, 2020, and the last emergency meeting, April 24th, 2020, of the Commission be approved for recording. There being no discussion and upon vote taken, motion unanimously approved.

Commissioner Garner moved, seconded by Commissioner Parker to approve a resolution to allow the Lauderdale County Sheriff's Department to transfer ownership of a recently acquired Glassmaster Boat and related items to the City of Sheffield. The items were recently transferred from the Florence-Lauderdale County Emergency Management Agency and the Sheriff's Department does not need the items. The City of Sheffield will take responsibility for usage, inventory, responsibility and maintenance. There being no discussion and upon a vote taken, motion unanimously approved. Resolution is herein recorded and made part of these minutes.

Commissioner Hackworth moved, seconded by Commissioner Parker to approve a resolution to authorize the CNCS Grant Application for the Retired Senior Volunteer Program (RSVP) for the year beginning April 1, 2020 and ending March 31, 2021. This funding is to be used as specified and within the timeframe allowed in the grant agreement for a grant total of forty-

nine thousand three hundred seventeen dollars. There being no discussion and upon a vote taken, motion unanimously approved. Resolution is herein recorded and made part of these minutes.

Commissioner Holmes moved, seconded by Commissioner Garner to approve a resolution to authorize a budget amendment for the Road Department. An overage occurring in Bid 2020-10 "Construction of a Metal Storage Building" shall be reconciled by excess funds in Bid 2020-9 "Bridge Repairs on CR 85 Over Cypress Creek", by line item only. Commissioner Hackworth asked Lauderdale County Engineer, Eric Hill, why there was such a surplus on the bridge project to create an overage and Mr. Hill stated that supply and demand had created higher prices last year, when the job was estimated, and costs had decreased substantially. Mr. Hill also stated that the construction of the metal building was more than originally anticipated. There being no further discussion and upon a vote taken, motion unanimously approved. Resolution and agreement are herein recorded and made part of these minutes.

Commissioner Parker moved, seconded by Commissioner Garner to approve a resolution to authorize Lauderdale County Solid Waste Department to hire two new full-time employees. These employees are needed as a result of adding the City of Rogersville to the County's garbage collection route. There being no discussion and upon a vote taken, motion unanimously approved. Resolution is herein recorded and made part of these minutes.

Commissioner Parker moved, seconded by Commissioner Hackworth to approve a resolution to authorize the Lauderdale County Solid Waste Department to enter into an agreement with Harris Local Government, a software provider. Harris Local Government provides software, hardware and professional services at a total net price of eighteen thousand four hundred fifty-nine dollars and ninety-eight cents with an annual support, maintenance and hosting fee of four thousand four hundred eighteen dollars and ninety cents. This will allow the Solid Waste Department to update their current software and interface with their existing system in order to more efficiently handle all aspects of customer records, including billing. There being no discussion and upon a vote taken, motion unanimously approved. Resolution and agreement are herein recorded and made part of these minutes.

Commissioner Garner moved, seconded by Commissioner Parker to approve a resolution to authorize support of an amendment to a Legislative Act as it relates to the Shoals Economic Development Fund and building of a Workforce Training and Development Center on property owned by the County. There being no discussion and upon a vote taken, motion unanimously approved. Resolution is herein recorded and made part of these minutes.

Commissioner Holmes, seconded by Commissioner Garner to approve a resolution to authorize the Lauderdale County Commission to enter into an agreement with the Alabama Department of Transportation (ALDOT) in order to define use of Rebuild Alabama Grant funds through the Rebuild Alabama Act Annual Grant Program. This agreement provides less restrictive use of the funds and allows the Lauderdale County Road Department to determine which road projects are most important to Lauderdale County. There being no discussion and upon a vote taken, motion unanimously approved. Resolution and agreement are herein recorded and made part of these minutes.

In compliance with bid laws of the State of Alabama, sealed bids were advertised for Bid No. LA 2020-7 "Cleaning Products Requiring Dispensers". Bids were received and publicly read aloud on April 20th, 2020. Chairman Pettus asked Lauderdale County Administrator, Brenda Bryant, for her recommendation. Ms. Bryant stated that only one bid was sent out due to the fact that no other company bid on these particular items in a previous bid sent out to eleven suppliers, including Ecolab, Inc.. Ms. Bryant recommends we go with the current provider of cleaning products requiring dispensers as they are the only company that participated in the bidding process for these products. Commissioner Parker moved, seconded by Commissioner Holmes, to follow

Ms. Bryant's recommendation. There being no discussion and upon a vote taken, motion unanimously approved. Bid is awarded to Ecolab, Inc. of St. Paul, Minnesota. Bid tabulation sheet is recorded and made part of these minutes.

Commissioner Garner moved, seconded by Commissioner Hackworth to approve leave requested by the Lauderdale County Sheriff's office for two of its deputies. FMLA has been requested for one deputy to begin on April 2nd, 2020, through June 26th, 2020. FMLA School Leave has been requested for another deputy to begin April 22nd, 2020, through May 22nd, 2020. There being no further discussion and upon a vote taken, motion unanimously approved.

Commissioner Hackworth moved, seconded by Commissioner Holmes to approve reappointment of Scott Haataja to the Florence Industrial Development Board with his reappointment expiring on April 5th, 2026. There being no discussion and upon a vote taken, motion unanimously approved.

The invoiced bills were audited, allowed, and ordered to be paid upon a motion by Commissioner Parker and seconded by Commissioner Holmes. After a brief discussion and upon a vote taken, motion unanimously approved.
