The Lauderdale County Commission convened at the Lauderdale County Courthouse in the City of Florence, Alabama, at 5:00 p.m. on the 28th day of September, 2020. The meeting was called to order by the Chairman of the Lauderdale County Commission, Danny Pettus. Upon roll call the following members answered present:

Chairman Danny Pettus, upon declaration of a quorum being present, opened the meeting for the transaction of business.

The invocation and Pledge of Allegiance were delivered by Commissioner Garner.

Awards and Presentations: Lauderdale County Sheriff, Rick Singleton, presented a plaque of appreciation to Mr. Rutherford, a seventeen-year reserve volunteer of the Lauderdale County Sheriff's Department. Sheriff Singleton thanked him for his dedication and service to the department.

Public Comments on Agenda Items: None

Commissioner Parker moved, seconded by Commissioner Garner that all items listed on the regular business agenda be approved for immediate consideration. There being no discussion and upon a vote taken, motion unanimously approved. Agenda is herein recorded and made a part of these minutes.

Commissioner Holmes moved, seconded by Commissioner Hackworth that the minutes of the last regular meeting of the Commission be approved for recording. There being no discussion and upon vote taken, motion unanimously approved.

Commissioner Parker moved, seconded by Commissioner Holmes to authorize a resolution that approves an amendment to a recent resolution to accurately reflect the effective date of payroll updates included in the budget. All payroll updates implemented by the FY2021 budget are effective as of October 4th, 2020. There being no discussion and upon a vote taken, motion unanimously approved. Resolution is herein recorded and made part of these minutes.

Commissioner Hackworth moved, seconded by Commissioner Parker to approve a resolution to authorize job description revisions for certain Lauderdale County positions. These job descriptions are being updated in order to more accurately reflect the duties of the following positions:

There being no discussion and upon a vote taken, motion unanimously approved. Resolution and updated job descriptions are herein recorded and made part of these minutes.

Commissioner Garner moved, seconded by Commissioner Holmes to authorize a resolution to approve renewal of original bid pricing for “General Office Supplies” with Printers & Stationers, Inc., of Florence, Alabama. Printers & Stationers, Inc. has agreed to honor their original bid pricing discount of 34.1% from their 2020-2021 office supplies catalog for the 2021 fiscal year. There being no further discussion and upon a vote taken, motion is unanimously approved. Resolution is herein recorded and made part of these minutes.

Commissioner Holmes moved, seconded by Commissioner Parker to authorize a resolution to approve payment for one detention bed for the juvenile court of Lauderdale County through the Alabama Department of Youth Services. The Commission approves this year’s contract and designates the Tennessee Valley Youth Detention Center as the facility to receive this year’s payment and approves any budget amendment necessary for this payment. There being no discussion and upon a vote taken, motion unanimously approved. Resolution is herein recorded and made part of these minutes.

Commissioner Holmes moved, seconded by Commissioner Hackworth to authorize a resolution to approve an amendment to the Project Agreement with the Amendment 666 Bond Commission for the Workforce Training Center Grant Program. This amendment will allow for reimbursement of costs relating to professional services and other soft costs for the Workforce Training Center Grant Program. Commissioner Holmes thanked everyone involved with this implementation of this program. There being no further discussion and upon a vote taken, motion is unanimously approved. Resolution is herein recorded and made part of these minutes.

Commissioner Garner moved, seconded by Commissioner Parker to authorize a resolution to approve an agreement with Goodwyn, Mills & Cawood, Inc., of Huntsville, Alabama, as designer for the Lauderdale County Work Development Center project with funds to be paid from the Workforce Training Center Grant Program. There being no discussion and upon a vote taken, motion is unanimously approved. Resolution is herein recorded and made part of these minutes.

Commissioner Parker moved, seconded by Commissioner Hackworth to authorize a resolution to approve an increase to the annual maximum retirement benefit cap for tax officials participating in the Supernumerary Program for retired tax officials under the previously offered program. The increase raises the annual maximum retirement benefit cap from forty-nine thousand six hundred dollars to fifty-nine thousand dollars effective October 1st, 2020.

There being no discussion and upon a vote taken, motion is approved. Resolution is herein recorded and made part of these minutes.

Commissioner Holmes moved, seconded by Commissioner Parker to authorize a resolution to approve an amendment to a recent resolution regarding the renewal of the existing Jail Telmate Tablet Program. This resolution is revised to correctly name Telmate, LLC, as renewing the original Mater Services Agreement with Lauderdale County. There being no discussion and upon a vote taken, motion unanimously approved. Resolution is herein recorded and made part of these minutes.

Commissioner Garner moved, seconded by Commissioner Hackworth to authorize a resolution to confirm the status of a Cooperation Agreement with the Florence Housing Authority and Lauderdale County dated March 27th, 1965, by a letter to the Florence Housing Authority signed by Danny Pettus on behalf of the Lauderdale County Commission. There being no discussion and upon a vote taken, motion unanimously approved. Resolution and letter are herein recorded and made part of these minutes.

Commissioner Holmes moved, seconded by Commissioner Garner to authorize a resolution to approve an application for a proposed plat review for the resurvey of seven lots in Crooked Cove Subdivision. Lauderdale County Engineer, Eric Hill, has reviewed this application and recommends its approval. There being no discussion and upon a vote taken, motion unanimously approved. Resolution is herein recorded and made part of these minutes.

Commissioner Garner moved, seconded by Commissioner Holmes to revoke a recent board appointment made to the East Lauderdale Water Authority board. Patricia Pettus will not be appointed to serve on this board since she does not reside in the East Lauderdale Water service area, which is a qualification of the position. There being no discussion and upon a vote taken, board appointment is revoked and recorded herein.

Commissioner Garner moved, seconded by Commissioner Hackworth to approve the reappointment of Rose Jones to the Shoals Economic Development Authority (SEDA) Board. Her term will begin immediately and expire on September 30th, 2023. There being no discussion and upon a vote taken, board appointment is approved and recorded herein.

Commissioner Hackworth moved, seconded by Commissioner Holmes to approve the reappointment of Chip Kasmeier and Horace Gray to the NACOLG Non-elected Board of Directors with their terms effective immediately and expiring September 30th, 2021. In addition, John Allgood will be appointed to replace Brenda Reeder, effective September 30th, 2020, through September 30th, 2021. There being no discussion and upon a vote taken, board appointments are approved and recorded herein.

In compliance with bid laws of the State of Alabama, sealed bids were advertised for Bid No. 2020-14 "State Street Roofing". Bids were received and publicly read aloud on September 11th, 2020. Chairman Pettus asked Lauderdale County Administrator, Brenda Bryant, for her recommendation. Ms. Bryant stated that she recommends the local vendor with a qualified bid, Mid-America Roofing, Inc., of Sheffield, Alabama, at a cost of forty-seven thousand six hundred seventy-three dollars. Commissioner Hackworth moved, seconded by Commissioner Parker, to follow Ms. Bryant's recommendation. Commissioner Holmes confirmed with Ms. Bryant that a bid bond or site visit was not provided by other low bidders. There being no further discussion and upon a vote taken, motion unanimously approved. Bid is awarded to Mid-America Roofing, Inc., of Sheffield, Alabama. Bid tabulation sheet is recorded and made part of these minutes.

In compliance with bid laws of the State of Alabama, sealed bids were advertised for Bid No. 2020-15 "License Vacuum System Construct". Bids were received and publicly read aloud on September 10th, 2020. Chairman Pettus asked Lauderdale County Administrator, Brenda Bryant, for her recommendation. Ms. Bryant stated that she recommends the only bidder, Pierce & Allred of Florence, Alabama, with a bid of forty-one thousand three hundred dollars.

Commissioner Parker moved, seconded by Commissioner Holmes, to follow Ms. Bryant's recommendation. Commissioner Hackworth asked Ms. Bryant if this was in the budget and she confirmed it was. There being no further discussion and upon a vote taken, motion unanimously approved. Bid is awarded to Pierce & Allred of Florence, Alabama. Bid tabulation sheet is recorded and made part of these minutes.

In compliance with bid laws of the State of Alabama, sealed bids were advertised for Bid No. 2020-16 "License Vacuum System Install". Bids were received and publicly read aloud on September 10th, 2020. Chairman Pettus asked Lauderdale County Administrator, Brenda Bryant, for her recommendation. Ms. Bryant stated that she recommends the only bidder, Quick Tube System, Incl, of Tomball, Texas, with a bid of forty-eight thousand dollars. Commissioner Hackworth moved, seconded by Commissioner Holmes, to follow Ms. Bryant's recommendation. Commissioner Garner asked about the two separate bids for this project and Ms. Bryant confirmed that the "License Vacuum System Construct" bid is for preparation of the building for the vacuum system, which is not performed by the vacuum installation company. Commissioner Hackworth asked if the contractor for the construction would work with the installer to complete the project to specifications and Ms. Bryant affirmed. There being no further discussion and upon a vote taken, motion unanimously approved. Bid is awarded to Quick Tube Systems, Inc., of Tomball, Texas. Bid tabulation sheet is recorded and made part of these minutes.

In compliance with bid laws of the State of Alabama, sealed bids were advertised for Bid No. 2021-1 "Crushed Stone". Bids were received and publicly read aloud on September 22nd, 2020. Chairman Pettus asked Lauderdale County Engineer, Eric Hill, for his recommendation. Mr. Hill stated that he recommends the vendor with lowest total bid, Rogers Group of Tuscumbia, Alabama. Commissioner Holmes asked about the price variation for washed stone and Mr. Hill stated that it was not a commonly used item. Commissioner Parker moved, seconded by Commissioner Garner, to follow Mr. Hill's recommendation. There being no further discussion and upon a vote taken, motion unanimously approved. Bid is awarded to Rogers Group of Tuscumbia, Alabama. Bid tabulation sheet is recorded and made part of these minutes.

In compliance with bid laws of the State of Alabama, sealed bids were advertised for Bid No. 2021-2 "Resurfacing Various Lauderdale County Roads". Bids were received and publicly read aloud on September 22nd, 2020. Chairman Pettus asked Lauderdale County Engineer, Eric Hill, for his recommendation. Mr. Hill stated that he recommends the vendor with the lowest total bid, Midsouth Paving, Inc., of Tuscumbia, Alabama. Commissioner Holmes moved, seconded by Commissioner Parker, to follow Mr. Hill's recommendation. There being no discussion and upon a vote taken, motion unanimously approved. Bid is awarded to Midsouth Paving, Inc., of Tuscumbia, Alabama. Bid tabulation sheet is recorded and made part of these minutes.

In compliance with bid laws of the State of Alabama, sealed bids were advertised for Bid No. 2021-4 "Hot Mix Asphalt". Bids were received and publicly read aloud on September 22nd, 2020. Chairman Pettus asked Lauderdale County Engineer, Eric Hill, for his recommendation. Mr. Hill stated that he recommends the vendor with the lowest total bid, Rogers Group of Tuscumbia, Alabama. Mr. Hill further stated that the only other bidder, Midsouth Paving, Inc., agreed to honor their own bid price if material was ever unavailable from Rogers Group. Commissioner Garner moved, seconded by Commissioner Hackworth, to follow Mr. Hill's recommendation. There being no further discussion and upon a vote taken, motion unanimously approved. Bid is awarded to Rogers Group of Tuscumbia, Alabama. Bid tabulation sheet is recorded and made part of these minutes.

All invoiced bills were audited, allowed and ordered to be paid upon by a motion made by Commissioner Parker and seconded by Commissioner Garner. There being no discussion and upon a vote taken, motion unanimously approved.


Public Comment Period:
