Chairman Danny Pettus, upon declaration of a quorum being present, opened the meeting for the transaction of business.

The invocation and Pledge of Allegiance were delivered by Commissioner Garner.

Commissioner Parker moved, seconded by Commissioner Garner that all items listed on the regular business agenda be approved for immediate consideration. There being no discussion and upon a vote taken, motion unanimously approved. Agenda is herein recorded and made a part of these minutes.

Commissioner Hackworth moved, seconded by Commissioner Parker that the minutes of the last regular meeting of the Commission be approved for recording. Commissioner Holmes abstained as he was absent from the meeting of October 13th, 2020. There being no discussion and upon vote taken, motion approved.

Commissioner Holmes moved, seconded by Commissioner Garner to authorize a resolution that approves the official holiday schedule received from the Governor's office declaring the following dates for observance during the 2020 Holiday Season:

There being no discussion and upon a vote taken, motion unanimously approved. Resolution is herein recorded and made part of these minutes.

Commissioner Parker moved, seconded by Commissioner Hackworth to approve a resolution to authorize an appropriation to the Shoals Area Chamber of Commerce Foundation in the amount of three hundred fifty dollars to be paid from the Tourism Fund. There being no discussion and upon a vote taken, motion unanimously approved. Resolution is herein recorded and made part of these minutes.

Commissioner Garner moved, seconded by Commissioner Parker to authorize a resolution to authorize payment to the Association of County Commission of Alabama (ACCA) Worker's Compensation Self-Insurers Fund in the amount of four hundred thousand one hundred two dollars and thirty-three cents. This annual payment covers all workers compensation and related legal costs for all County Departments. Resolution is herein recorded and made part of these minutes.

Commissioner Holmes moved, seconded by Commissioner Parker to authorize a resolution to approve a "No Truck Route" designation for County Road 389 beginning at County Road 25 heading east then south for .8 miles until it intersects with County Road 34. Commissioner Parker asked Lauderdale County Engineer, Eric Hill, if a study had been conducted regarding this designation. Mr. Hill confirmed that a study had been done and it was determined that the road is not designed for large trucks to safely travel and recommends this designation. There being no further discussion and upon a vote taken, motion unanimously approved. Resolution is herein recorded and made part of these minutes.

Commissioner Hackworth moved, seconded by Commissioner Holmes to authorize a resolution to renew a license agreement with Diversified Computer Services for software and services for the Lauderdale County Road Department for fiscal year 2021 and any budget amendment necessary in the implementation and continuation of this agreement. There being no discussion and upon a vote taken, motion unanimously approved. Resolution is herein recorded and made part of these minutes.

Commissioner Holmes moved, seconded by Commissioner Hackworth to authorize a resolution regarding the agreement to purchase the City of Florence's interest in the jointly owned Government Building located at 102 South Court Street in Florence. The City will continue to occupy part of the government building and pay a percentage portion of utilities in lieu of traditional rent. The City will also assign its interest in a lease agreement with the Florence Board of Education providing for the use of designated space at the Government Building by the Board of Education. Chairman Danny Pettus is authorized to sign the three-year lease agreement with the City of Florence and the assignment of the Board of Education lease. There being no discussion and upon a vote taken, motion unanimously approved. Resolution is herein recorded and made part of these minutes.

In compliance with bid laws of the State of Alabama, sealed bids were advertised for Bid No. 2021-5 "Stripping Various Lauderdale County Roads". Bids were received and publicly read aloud on October 20th, 2020. Chairman Pettus asked Lauderdale County Engineer, Eric Hill, for his recommendation. Mr. Hill recommended the lowest bidder, Riverside Traffic Systems, as we have used them in the past with good results. Commissioner Hackworth moved, seconded by Commissioner Parker to follow Mr. Hill's recommendation and award the bid to Riverside. There being no discussion and upon a vote taken, motion unanimously approved. Bid is awarded to Riverside Traffic Systems of New Albany, Mississippi. Bid tabulation sheet is recorded and made part of these minutes.

All invoiced bills were audited, allowed and ordered to be paid upon by a motion made by Commissioner Parker and seconded by Commissioner Garner. There being no discussion and upon a vote taken, motion unanimously approved.


WHEREAS, authorization is required for the Chairman of the County Commission to sign the aforementioned lease and assignment of lease on behalf of the Lauderdale County Commission.






