The change order is necessary due to an existing cooling compressor being too close to the building and existing wiring located where a new door is to be installed. The change order will adjust the contract price to two hundred forty-six thousand two hundred sixty-seven dollars and completion date to October 11<sup>th</sup>, 2020. Any budget amendment needed is also herein approved. There being no discussion and upon a vote taken, motion unanimously approved. Resolution is herein recorded and made part of these minutes.

Commissioner Parker moved, seconded by Commissioner Garner to authorize a resolution to approve a roof lease agreement between the Lauderdale County Commission and T-Mobile regarding their tower occupying roof space atop the Government Building located at 102 South Court Street. The five-year agreement will begin June 30<sup>th</sup>, 2021, with rent due annually at a rate of thirteen thousand two hundred thirty-seven dollars and eighty-six cents. The agreement will automatically renew for four successive renewal terms of five years each and rent will be adjusted each renewal term by ten percent over the then current rate. There being no discussion and upon a vote taken, motion unanimously approved. Resolution is herein recorded and made part of these minutes.

Commissioner Holmes moved, seconded by Commissioner Garner to table an item on today's agenda regarding the possible purchase of property at 730 Mitchell Boulevard. A discussion was held about this site and its suitability for the purpose of constructing a new 911 location for the City and County. A new site will become necessary in the near future due to the City's plans for the current location of the 911 offices and it was determined that the conversation must begin but more discussion needs to be had before a decision is made. There being no further discussion and upon a vote taken, motion unanimously approved. Item is tabled to allow for further information to be obtained regarding this item before it is voted upon by the Commission.

Commissioner Hackworth moved, seconded by Commissioner Parker to authorize a resolution to approve the Lauderdale County Solid Waste Department to participate with the City of Florence in applying for funds through the 2021 ADEM Grant Application. If granted, the funds will be used for the Lauderdale County Recycling Program to purchase an enclosed trailer for fourteen thousand eight hundred one dollars and a ¾-ton pickup truck at a cost of thirty-eight thousand dollars. Lauderdale County will match 25% of funds for the truck for a total cost to the county of nine thousand five hundred dollars. The City of Florence will be the lead applicant for the grant and the Commission approves any budget amendment necessary for the financial management of this grant. There being no discussion and upon a vote taken, motion unanimously approved. Resolution is herein recorded and made part of these minutes.
