Chairman Danny Pettus, upon declaration of a quorum being present, opened the meeting for the transaction of business.

The invocation and Pledge of Allegiance were delivered by Commissioner Parker.

Commissioner Parker moved, seconded by Commissioner Garner that all items listed on the regular business agenda be approved for immediate consideration. There being no discussion and upon a vote taken, motion unanimously approved. Agenda is herein recorded and made a part of these minutes.

Commissioner Hackworth moved, seconded by Commissioner Garner that the minutes of the last regular meeting of the Commission be approved for recording. There being no discussion and upon vote taken, motion unanimously approved.

Commissioner Hackworth moved, seconded by Commissioner Parker to approve a resolution to authorize homeland security grant funding. EMA Grant 21LET, in the amount of seventy-two thousand seven hundred fifteen dollars and sixty-six cents, will be used to support the law enforcement team based out of the Florence Police Department. There being no discussion and upon a vote taken, motion unanimously approved. Resolution is herein recorded and made part of these minutes.

Commissioner Garner moved, seconded by Commissioner Black to approve a resolution to authorize emergency management grant funding. EMA Grant 22EMPG, in the amount of one thousand two hundred ninety-four dollars, will be used for emergency management preparedness programs for EMA. There being no discussion and upon a vote taken, motion unanimously approved. Resolution is herein recorded and made part of these minutes.

Commissioner Parker moved, seconded by Commissioner Garner to approve a resolution to authorize homeland security grant funding. EMA Grant 22FIL, in the amount of eighty thousand four hundred thirty-four dollars, will be used for Florence Fire Rescue equipment. There being no discussion and upon a vote taken, motion unanimously approved. Resolution is herein recorded and made part of these minutes.

Commissioner Hackworth moved, seconded by Commissioner Garner to approve a resolution to authorize a license agreement renewal with Permitium, LLC. This agreement is between the Lauderdale County Sheriff's Department and Permitium, LLC, for software and services related to pistol permit processes and is effective October 1<sup>st</sup>, 2022, through September 30<sup>th</sup>, 2023. There being no discussion and upon a vote taken, motion unanimously approved. Resolution is herein recorded and made part of these minutes.

Commissioner Parker moved, seconded by Commissioner Black to approve a resolution to authorize an increase in appropriation to the Lauderdale County Association of Volunteer Fire Departments. The cost of fuel has had a direct impact on all Volunteer Fire Departments and the Commission agrees to increase the appropriation for fiscal year 2023 and beyond from two hundred thousand dollars to two hundred twenty-two thousand eight hundred dollars. There being no discussion and upon a vote taken, motion unanimously approved. Resolution is herein recorded and made part of these minutes.

Commissioner Hackworth moved, seconded by Commissioner Garner to approve a resolution to authorize a Memorandum of Understanding with the Alabama Forever Wild Land Trust (FWLT). Per Amendment 543 of the Alabama Constitution, FWLT may pay funds to Lauderdale County for land owned by FWLT as we cooperate to preserve natural lands and waters of environmental and recreational importance for the benefit of future generations. A discussion was held regarding the scope of this agreement and it was decided that a roll call vote would be taken with the following results:

There being no further discussion and upon the vote taken, motion approved. Resolution is herein recorded and made part of these minutes.

Bids for Bid No. LA 2023-3 "Various Printing Jobs" were received, publicly opened and read aloud on November 10<sup>th</sup>, 2022. Chairman Pettus referred to County Administrator, Brenda Bryant, for her recommendation. Ms. Bryant stated that bids were received from Printers & Stationers (PSI) and Herald Printing. Ms. Bryant recommended that the bid be awarded to the lowest bidder for each item – Detention Center Receipt Books from PSI at a cost of four hundred thirty-seven dollars and fifty cents for a quantity of twenty-five, Sheriff Evidence Submission Forms from PSI at a cost of three hundred nineteen dollars for a quantity of two thousand, Reappraisal Property Error Change Forms from Herald at a cost of two hundred sixty dollars and fifty cents for a quantity of four thousand, County Commission Requisition Books at a cost of six hundred twenty one dollars and fifty cents for a quantity of fifty, and County Commission Letterhead at a cost of one hundred twenty-nine dollars for a quantity of one thousand. Commissioner Parker moved, seconded by Commissioner Garner to award the bid as recommended. There being no discussion and upon a vote taken, motion unanimously approved. Bid awarded to Printers & Stationers and Herald Printing of Florence, Alabama.

Bids for Bid No. LA 2023-4 "Barn Construction for Animal Services" were received, publicly opened and read aloud on November 14<sup>th</sup>, 2022. Chairman Pettus referred to County Administrator, Brenda Bryant, for her recommendation. Ms. Bryant stated that one bid was received and she recommends we award that bid to Brinks Fence Company at a cost

of forty-seven thousand three hundred fifteen dollars. Commissioner Parker moved, seconded by Commissioner Garner to award the bid as recommended. There being no discussion and upon a vote taken, motion unanimously approved. Bid awarded to Brinks Fence Company of Florence, Alabama.

All invoiced bills were audited, allowed and ordered to be paid upon by a motion made by Commissioner Parker seconded by Commissioner Hackworth. There being no discussion and upon a vote taken, motion unanimously approved.

# RESOLUTION OF THE LAUDERDALE COUNTY COMMISSION

AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF AN AGREEMENT WITH THE FOREVER WILD LAND TRUST and PROVIDING THAT CONTINUED FUNDING IS SUBJECT TO THE LEGAL AVAILABALITY OF FUNDS.

WHEREAS, Amendment 543 of the Alabama Constitution of 1901 creates the Forever Wild Land Trust (FWLT) for the purpose of identifying, acquiring, managing, protecting and conserving natural lands and waters that are of environmental or recreational importance for the benefit of future generations; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees for the Alabama Forever Wild Land Trust governs the FWLT, and is authorized at its discretion to cooperate and contract with County Commissions to accomplish the purposes and goals of Amendment 543, including to effect payment of reasonable fees in connection with such cooperation efforts; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees, as the fiduciary for the FWLT, wishes to cooperate and enter into an agreement with each county in which FWLT owns acreage by paying, on an annual basis, a reasonable fee for the support, promotion, protection, and conservation of such lands within the county; and

WHEREAS, the Lauderdale County Commission recognizes that the proposed funding serves a valid and compelling public purpose; and

WHEREAS, the Lauderdale County Commission acknowledges that this proposed funding is subject to the legal availability of funds for this purpose in each fiscal year; and

WHEREAS, the Lauderdale County Commission agrees to participate in the funding opportunity and to comply with all terms and conditions of said Agreement, this Resolution, and related documents; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Lauderdale County Commission specifically instructs and authorizes the Chairman of the Lauderdale County Commission or his/her designee to enter into the Agreement with the FWLT, and further authorizes the Chairman of the County Commission or his/her designee to execute any and all documents deemed necessary to effectuate the transfer of funds.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that a copy of this Resolution be duly reflected upon the minutes of the November 16<sup>th</sup>, 2022 meeting of the Lauderdale County Commission and be immediately forwarded to the State Lands Division of the Alabama Department of Conservation and Natural Resources.
